- _____ 6. Secure Section 136(**School Year Practice**) of the TAPPS Manual.
- _____ 7. Secure Section 139 (**Non School and Summer Participation**) of the TAPPS Manual. (www.tapps.net)
- _____ 8. Complete TAPPS SCOPE as required.
- _____ 9. Secure Section 141 (**Playoff Format**) of the TAPPS Manual.
- _____ 10. Review district rules and tie breakers.
- _____ 11. Sign a **Professional Acknowledgement of Rules Form** for file in the head administrator's office. (**See Athletic Director**)
- _____ 12. Secure a copy of the **FIFA** rules for Soccer to be brought to each contest.
- _____ 13. Insure that the **Eligibility Form** is sent to the TAPPS state office **before participation in the first game.** A Supplemental **Eligibility Form** may be sent at any time during the season to add additional runners.
- _____ 14. Each athlete has **Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form** (if required by school) and **Student Acknowledgement of Rules Form** (www.tapps.net) on file.
- _____ 15. Prepare statistics and attend All District/District Certification meeting.
- _____ 16. Submit team roster and photo for state program by date shown on TAPPS calendar.
- _____ 17. For any eligible student, complete and submit the Academic All State Form located on the TAPPS website. (www.tapps.net)
